This design consists of additional parking through a parking lot and existing road, restrooms, a basketball court, shade structures, picnic area and pavilions, a large playground set, and a splash pad.

Group 4's design was the runner up with 4 votes. This design proposes additional parking, lined trees along the existing road, a rose garden with art sculpture, bathrooms, a large and small playground set, shade structures, a basketball court, and an adult fitness area with misters.
